

WomanACT General Membership: The general membership is made up of senior level representatives of each of the key sectors in the community response to woman abuse. As a coordinating body, the general membership: identifies gaps in service, supports and facilitates policy development and pilot projects, and undertakes research and actions that promote institutional and systemic change.

THSP Network: The Transitional and Housing Support Program (THSP) Network is a dynamic Network dedicated to promoting effective, consistent and high quality responses that break the cycle of violence and address women's and children's need for safe and affordable housing and transitional support to ensure their safety and self-sufficiency. A total of 21 agencies are members of the THSP Network.

VAW/CAS Committee: The Violence against Women and Children Aid Societies Advisory Committee is a community based advisory group that flows important information and recommendations to the provincial government and works across the CAS/VAW sector to increase collaboration and enhance service delivery for women and children. Membership on the Committee is organizational and includes one representative from each signatory organization or funder, namely the Ministry of Community and Social Services and the Ministry of Child and Youth Services.

WomanACT Standing Committees: The standing committees offer the opportunity for members to work on specific areas of interest and concern. The Committees of the Council include a number of sector-specific committees including Health, Shelter, Support Services Cultural Issues. One of the longest standing committees of the Council is Women's Voices for Action made up of women with lived experience.

WomanACT Board of Directors: The role of the Board is to provide overall direction, monitoring and supervision for the organization in keeping with its mission, vision, values and contractual liabilities. At least 6 shall come from the membership and up to 5 may be community at large members
